

Proceedings of Regular Board Meeting

March 9, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Village President, Mark Bade, at 6 pm. Present were Trustees; Ziebell & Rybicki. Absent were Trustees; Haupt & Dorshorst. The meeting was started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Trustee Ziebell moved that the minutes of last month's meeting be approved as typed and distributed. Bade seconded. Motion carried.

Trustee Ziebell moved that the Rudolph Volunteer Fire Dept. be granted a picnic beer license for their steak feed on April 9th. Rybicki seconded. Motion carried.

A new contract for building inspector was discussed. Dan Hanson, our current building inspector will be invited to next month's to discuss the new contract. One item that will be addressed is the responsibility of collecting the sewer hook-up charges for the sewer system.

A letter has been received by some of the residents advising them that their census form will be arriving shortly. We are to encourage that everyone respond promptly.

Per a letter received from the Railroad Commissioner we were advised that the County Highway C project (Main Street) will be delayed until 2011. President Bade called the County Highway Dept. about this and was told the engineers are not ready.

The Village was able to get a large pile of salted sand from the transmission line reconstruction crew for hauling it away. A tarp is needed to cover it and we will look at getting a cheaper one to last one year.

The sewer report was good but the chloride and ammonia levels are rising.

Information to be included with the April 1st sewer billing on a letter was discussed.

Roger Hartjes will be contacted about possibly screening the compost pile at the compost site and making it available to residents for their use.

Stan Charron of MSA attended the meeting and went again over the facility plan. Bade moved to authorize MSA to submit the plan to the DNR on the Village's behalf. Ziebell seconded. Motion carried.

A meeting to go over a proposed contract with the City of Wisconsin Rapids to treat the Village's sewage will be held on the 23rd of March. At 1pm.

The listed bills were read and approved for payment.

On motion and vote the meeting was adjourned.
