

Proceedings of Regular Board Meeting

November 8, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Village President, Mark Bade, at 6 pm. Present were Trustees; Dorshorst, Ziebell, Rybicki, and Haupt. Absent; none. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Haupt moved that the minutes of the preceding meeting be approved as typed and distributed. Ziebell seconded. Motion carried.

Jason Nieman again came before the Board in regard to his desire to rezone a portion of his property to Commercial B-2. He now has the desired area staked out and on a plat map. A public hearing will be held on the request for rezoning at 6pm on December 13th before the regular Board meeting. Notices to adjoining property owners are to be sent out and posting put up for the general public.

Sewer rates were again discussed and the question in regard to storage units rates will remain as currently is.

Alvin Blair has expressed an interest in the vacant Village employee position and President Bade will be talking to him in regard to this.

It was decided that Wayne Basler will not be able to build another outbuilding on his property as it is currently platted out. This was because of his applying for a building permit to build a second one on his property.

The sewer report for the month was very good.

Trustee Rybicki stated that an assortment of tools is needed at the Ag Building storage site. This is necessary as previous employees were primarily using their own tools. Bade moved and Dorshorst seconded that Rybicki be authorized to obtain up to \$200.00 worth. Motion carried.

We will need a box of red and a box of green bulbs for replacements on the Christmas decorations. Also needed are the bars for replacement in 3 brackets for banner display. Trustee Ziebell will order.

Dorshorst Trucking will chip the brush piles and haul away at no charge to the Village.

The listed bills were approved for payment.

On motion and vote the meeting was adjourned.
